# Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Policy

## Miles Import S.A.S. — Commitment to Sustainability

Miles Import, an IFS Broker v3.2, GlobalGAP CoC v6.1, FeL Partnership certified fresh fruit importer and Sustainable Market certified, is resolutely committed to a structured CSR approach. Our CSR policy is based on the values of trust, reliability, food safety and a sense of service.

### Our Mission

To introduce French consumers to the diversity of crops through the fruits we import from 39 countries via our 150 active suppliers. Our expertise covers citrus fruits, exotic fruits, grapes and cherries.

### Our commitments

#### Commitment 1: Employee well-being

Miles Import guarantees optimal conditions for well-being at work. We train and develop the skills of our 10 employees in quality, food safety and professional development (IFS Broker v3.2 §3).

#### Commitment 2: Eco-responsible agriculture

We support our producers in adopting environmentally friendly production methods. Miles Import integrates the monitoring of pesticide residues (Decree of 05/01/2026), PFAS control and GlobalGAP compliance to ensure the sustainability of the sectors.

#### Commitment 3: Responsible Consumption

We raise consumer awareness about healthy and sustainable food. Miles Import encourages the diversity of fruits and makes exotic fruits accessible to as many people as possible.

#### Commitment 4: Reducing Environmental Impact

We work with our logistics partners (including Condiprim S.A.S.) to minimise the ecological footprint, optimise transport and reduce food waste.

We are in line with Regulation (EU) 2023/1115 (EUDR) against imported deforestation, applicable to operators from December 2026.

#### Commitment 5: Due Diligence and Due Diligence

Although Miles Import is not directly subject to Directive (EU) 2024/1760 (CSDDD), we voluntarily adopt a due diligence approach with our suppliers, anticipated by our Supplier Code of Conduct (ENR-30) and our Responsible Purchasing Charter (ENR-28).

### Respect for Human Rights and Social Norms

Miles Import complies with all applicable laws. We guarantee fair working conditions, without discrimination, in accordance with the ILO Core Conventions, the UN Global Compact and our Sedex Plus registration.
